Hardcourt, Clay and Grass Grand Prix
April 24th-26th, 2026
Deadline for Entry April 1st, 2026

In every division our format assures that each team will get to play on all three surfaces. Teams must play all three rounds. Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. (16 team draws will have a 4th and final round for the last two teams standing on Sunday)

We offer Men's, Women's & Mixed Doubles in the following categories: 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5, 5.0

We have one combo Mixed draw: 9.5 (both players combined NTRP ratings cannot exceed 9.5)

We offer Men's/Women's 60's & 70's age divisions. **(4 teams minimum are required to hold these events)**

The cost is \$110 per player for the first draw entered.

\$95 per player for the second draw entered. **One partner will enter their doubles team online and will pay for both partners.**

Important: The online entry system will ask you if this is your second entry in this year's tournament. If it is your second entry in this year's Mission Hills tournament specifically, answer the question as yes. This will provide the player that is entering a second event with a discount on their second entry. If the player is only playing one event (draw) answer the question as no. The

intent of the question has nothing to do with whether you have played this tournament in previous years.

In all NTRP level draws, players may play two events. Gender and Mixed. However, you must play in the same NTRP level in both draws. (9.5 combo mixed is the only exception)

Entries are time stamped. Our online entry system accepts all entries, but draw sizes are limited to 8 teams or 16 teams. Teams that fall outside the 8 or 16 team draws will be advised that they are “wait listed” shortly after their entries are received. Should wait listed teams not get into a draw their entries will be refunded approximately one week prior to the tournament.

Schedule Accommodations & Refund/Substitution Policy:

As a reminder, there are no match time accommodations for this event. It must run as scheduled. No exceptions. You must be able to play as scheduled, morning, afternoon & night. If you cannot play as early as 8 AM on Friday of the event, or as late as 5 PM on Sunday, do not enter.

A note to Mission Hills members: It is highly likely that you may have a clay match at a different facility other than Mission Hills. It is impossible to schedule members to play all their clay matches at Mission Hills due to the complexity of the schedule. If this presents any problem at all, please do not enter the tournament.

It is also important to restate the policy that has been in effect for many years concerning this tournament regarding player or team withdrawals and refunds. The rules when entering this tournament are "No Refunds." However, if players or teams find out that they



are unable to compete, prior to the first match, you must follow this procedure:

1) If just changing a partner you can email or call me at mjbailin@aol.com or 760-285-4688.

If a complete team withdrawal is necessary, call or email me to advise me of the situation and see if we have a team on the wait list.

2) If no team is on the wait list you will be responsible for finding a replacement. (I can try to assist, but I cannot guaranty success)

3) If no paid team or player is available the CVGP will look to gift the spot to a replacement team. Refunds will be contingent upon the amount received by the CVGP from the replacement team.

Ratings Changes after 12/31/25:

Since entries for this tournament are taken prior to the USTA annual ratings change at the end of December, some players that are holding guaranteed spots in a particular draw may have their rating increased. If this happens it is required that those players that have had an increase in rating reach out to Michael immediately. These re-rated players will not be allowed to remain in their former NTRP level. If there is room for the affected players in the higher-level draw then I will move them. If the higher-level draw is sold out, they will go onto the wait list. If one partner does not have an increase, they may keep the spot and find a new replacement partner.
